All activities based in the grounds of White Hall Centre at Buxton. These could include: Ropes Course, Zip Wire, Indoor Climbing Wall, Orienteering, Various problem solving / team building activities. Can take up to 60 people.

The cost per person for a weekend residential course is £67.55 from 10.00am Saturday - 5.00pm Sunday (Lunch Saturday - Lunch Sunday). The above cost includes full board accommodation, tuition, and transport during your stay and any necessary specialist equipment. A programme of activities including evening activities is also part of the cost.

After 5.00 pm on Saturday we will have 2 members of staff to run an evening activity and one overnight duty instructor will be on call from 10.00 pm.
