




Local entrepreneurs get FREE support

A free-to-use support service to help ambitious entrepreneurs set up and run successful new businesses has launched in the Derbyshire Dales. The Sheffield City Region (SCR) Launchpad service - delivered locally by Growing Rural Enterprise Ltd on behalf of Derbyshire Dales District Council - helps individuals thinking of starting a business, new businesses registered but not yet trading and businesses trading for up to 24 months who need help with their growth plans. For the next two and a half years the service will offer one-to-one, face-to-face advice as well as a programme of events and workshops to eligible clients across the district. Mentoring support will also be available through the main SCR Launchpad programme. The service is part funded by the European Regional Development Fund with the remaining funding provided by the District Council. A joint event on Sheep & Cattle recording and CPH rationalisation is being held by NFU & Bagshaws on Wednesday 23rd November at the Agricultural Centre, Bakewell. Too many farms are being docked BPS money for simple failures when sheep and cattle records are inspected. With CPH rationalisation now taking place this is a good time for everybody to have a refresher on what is required. For example, 'are you recording the date when you tag your lambs?'. Failure to do so can cost 1.5% of your BPS payment. If you have more than one holding number or you send livestock onto another holding for grazing or winter then
